

Northumberland County Forest's off-road recreational trail system is a mix of forest roads, double-track and, for off-road motorcycles, single-track trails. All motorized trails are shared with non-motorized users.

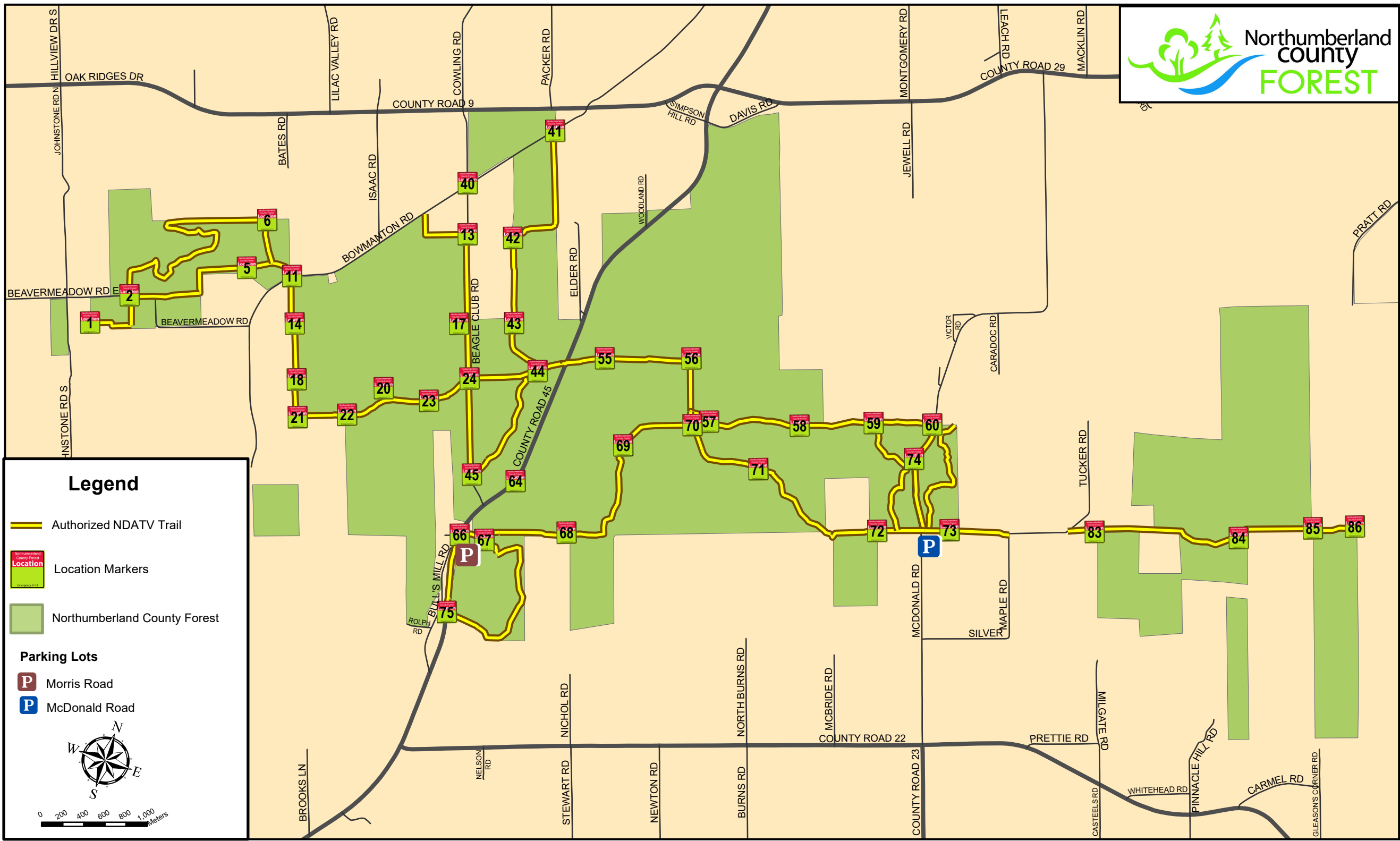

Memberships cannot be purchased at a Northumberland County Office.

- Respect the Forest's neighbours, other users and wildlife. Keep the sound of your machine to a minimum.
- When you encounter horseback riders, please shut off engine and follow the rider's instructions.
- Only use designated trails (follow signage and map).
- Avoid wet/muddy areas when possible, but please stay on trail.
- Use of hill-climbs, mud holes and sand openings is prohibited.
- Motorized trail uses other than snowmobiling are prohibited between November 1st and May 15th.
